Relating to sale of alcoholic beverages by a package store licensee.

Relating to sale of alcoholic beverages by a
package store licensee.

* Section 1. AS 04.11.150(a) is amended to read:

(a) Except as provided under (h) of this section, a package store license authorizes the holder to sell alcoholic beverages to a person in response to a verbal solicitation for purchase received from the person present on the licensed premises or in response to a written solicitation made by a person known to the licensee for a purchase to be received by the person making the solicitation. The package store licensee, agent, or employee shall include written information on fetal alcohol syndrome and fetal alcohol effects resulting from a woman consuming alcohol during pregnancy in each shipment of alcoholic beverages sold in response to a written solicitation.
