AN ACT

Requiring notice to obligors about obligations relating to support.

* Section 1. AS 47.23.120 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

(c) Within 30 days after the agency knows the identity and address of an obligor who resides in the state and who is liable to the state under this section, the agency shall send written notification by certified mail to the obligor parent of the obligor's accruing liability. The notice required under this subsection must be in clear, concise, and easily readable language. The notice may accompany other communications by the agency.

(d) If the agency fails to comply with (c) of this section, interest does not accrue on the liability to the state unless a support order has been entered.

(e) The agency's failure to comply with (c) of this section does not bar an action by the state to recover amounts owed by the obligor.
