Sec. 18.60.580. MINIMUM ELECTRICAL STANDARDS. The 1990 [1987] published edition of the National Electrical Code (ANSI/NFPA) approved by the American National Standards Institute on August 7, 1989 [JULY 30, 1986], and the 1990 [1987] published edition of the National Electrical Safety Code (ANSI C2-1990 [C2-1987]) approved by the American National Standards Institute on June 26, 1989 [JUNE 23, 1986], constitute the minimum electrical safety standards of the state.

\* Sec. 2. AS 18.60.590(a) is amended to read:

(a) The department may by regulation adopt amendments to the 1990 [1987] National Electrical Code as approved and issued by the American National Standards Institute [ASSOCIATION].
