Supporting construction of road access to the City of Whittier.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS there is no road access to the City of Whittier; and

WHEREAS road access to the City of Whittier is necessary to promote the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Whittier and to promote economic development of the community; and

WHEREAS the construction of a road to the City of Whittier will require access across the Chugach National Forest; and

WHEREAS the United States Forest Service must grant permission for a road to cross national forest land; and

WHEREAS the construction of a road to the City of Whittier is for an essential governmental purpose;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature supports the construction of road access to the City of Whittier; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests the U.S. Forest Service to identify a transportation corridor for a road to Whittier and to give the necessary permission for construction of a road across the Chugach National Forest.
