Endorsing the change of the name of Anchor Point Avenue in Anchor Point to Milo Fritz Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Kenai Peninsula Borough has requested the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to approve a change of the name of Anchor Point Avenue in Anchor Point to Milo Fritz Avenue; and

WHEREAS Milo H. Fritz served the state and its people as physician and three-term state legislator; and

WHEREAS the renaming of Anchor Point Avenue to Milo Fritz Avenue would commemorate Milo H. Fritz and his contributions to the people of the state; and

WHEREAS Anchor Point Avenue was not constructed by the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities and thus may be named without enactment of law;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature endorses the renaming of Anchor Point Avenue to Milo Fritz Avenue; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to favorably consider and to approve the renaming of Anchor Point Avenue in Anchor Point to Milo Fritz Avenue.
