Establishing Alaska Archaeology Week as April 2 - 8, 1990.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the state's numerous archaeological sites reflect a prehistory and history rich in cultural diversity; and

WHEREAS preservation of prehistoric and historic archaeological sites provides significant cultural and educational benefits to all citizens; and

WHEREAS knowledge and understanding of the state's cultural heritage is threatened by illegal destruction of archaeological sites; and

WHEREAS designation of a special week would help promote programs to educate and inform the public about the state's archaeological resources and encourage their protection;

BE IT RESOLVED the the Alaska State Legislature establishes April 2 - 8, 1990, as Alaska Archaeology Week to be recognized through appropriate public events held throughout the state.

COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Manuel Lujan, Jr., Secretary of the Interior; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Frank Murkowski, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable Don Young, U.S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
