Relating to holding the Greatland Games in the Palmer and Wasilla area in conjunction with the Alaska State Fair.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Greatland Games is the name of a rapidly growing state sports festival for amateur sports enthusiasts from all over Alaska; and

WHEREAS establishing a more permanent location for the games will allow the games to be more satisfactorily scheduled and properly promoted and will encourage many more potential competitors to participate; and

WHEREAS the communities in the greater Palmer and Wasilla areas have the facilities needed to host the games in conjunction with the Alaska State Fair; and

WHEREAS the games were held successfully at the Alaska State Fair in 1988 after the Governor endorsed the games by executive proclamation; and

WHEREAS the city of Palmer and the city of Wasilla have adopted resolutions supporting the holding of the games in the greater Palmer and Wasilla area in conjunction with the Alaska State Fair;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature supports holding the Greatland Games in the Palmer and Wasilla area as an added attraction of the Alaska State Fair.
