5 * Section 1. AS 11.46.482(a) is amended to read:

6 (a) A person commits the crime of criminal mischief in the second degree if, having no
7 right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe the person has such a right,

8 (1) with intent to damage property of another, the person damages property of
9 another in an amount of \$500 or more;

10 (2) the person tampers with an oil or gas pipeline or supporting facility or an
11 airplane or helicopter with reckless disregard for the risk of harm to or loss of the property;

12 (3) the person recklessly creates a risk of damage in an amount exceeding
13 \$100,000 to property of another by the use of widely dangerous means; [OR]

14 (4) the person drives, tows away, or takes the propelled vehicle of another and
15 the vehicle or any other property of another is damaged or the owner incurs reasonable expenses
16 as a result of the loss of use of the vehicle in a total amount of \$500 or more; or

17 (5) the person drives, tows away, or takes the propelled vehicle of another
18 and the vehicle is marked as a police or emergency vehicle.
