AN ACT

1 Amending the definition of slow-leaching TBT-based marine antifouling paint.
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5 * Section 1. AS 46.03.715(e)(1) is amended to read:

6 (1) "slow-leaching TBT-based marine antifouling paint" means a TBT-based
7 marine antifouling paint, but not a coating or other treatment, that has a measured release rate
8 equal to or less than the maximum release rate established for qualified antifouling paints
9 containing organotin by [3.0 MICROGRAMS PER SQUARE CENTIMETER PER DAY AT
10 STEADY STATE CONDITIONS DETERMINED UNDER] the U.S. Environmental Protection
11 Agency under 33 U.S.C. 2401 - 2410 (the Organotin Antifouling Paint Control Act of 1988)
12 [TESTING PROCEDURE, AS OUTLINED IN THE AGENCY'S CALL-IN NOTICE OF
13 JULY 29, 1986, ON TRIBUTYLTIN IN ANTIFOULING PAINTS UNDER 7 U.S.C. 136-136Y
14 (THE FEDERAL INSECTICIDE, FUNGICIDE, AND RODENTICIDE ACT)];
