3 * Section 1. AS 14.25.168 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 retirement that the health insurance coverage available to retired members may be different from
6 the health insurance coverage provided to employees. The administrator shall also notify those
7 members of time limits for selecting optional health insurance coverage and whether the election
8 is irrevocable. A member who has requested appointment to retirement shall indicate in writing
9 on a form provided by the administrator that the member has received the information required
10 by this subsection and whether the member has chosen to receive optional health insurance
11 coverage.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 22.25.090 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

15 * Sec. 4. In implementing former AS 39.37.145, concerning medical benefits, the administrator shall

17 available to retired members may be different from the health insurance coverage provided to employees.
18 The administrator shall also notify those members of time limits for selecting optional health insurance
19 coverage and whether the election is irrevocable. A member who has requested appointment to
20 retirement shall indicate in writing on a form provided by the administrator that the member has received
21 the information required by this subsection and whether the member has chosen to receive optional
22 health insurance coverage.
