Relating to nonconcurrence in adjournment of the Second Special Session of the Seventeenth Alaska State Legislature.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS under Article II, Section 10, Constitution of the State of Alaska, neither house may adjourn or recess for longer than three days unless the other concurs; and

WHEREAS the House adjourned sine die on June 20, 1992, from the Second Special Session of the Seventeenth Alaska State Legislature; and

WHEREAS under Uniform Rule 52 adoption of a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the full membership of each house constitutes concurrence in an adjournment for longer than three days; and

WHEREAS a concurrent resolution has not been adopted under Uniform Rule 52;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate does not concur in the adjournment on June 20, 1992, by the House from the Second Special Session of the Seventeenth Alaska State Legislature.
