Declaring June 5 - 11, 1994, as Alaska Garden Week.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS gardening instills in all Alaskans a greater appreciation of nature, the values of conservation, pollution control, and enhancement of the environment; and

WHEREAS this awareness and appreciation heightens each citizen's sense of responsibility for and trusteeship of this great state; and

WHEREAS gardening efforts bring beauty to communities and promote individual and community pride; and

WHEREAS gardening has established and sustained \$28,000,000 in horticultural businesses in this state; and

WHEREAS the Alaska State Federation of Garden Clubs and the University of Alaska Cooperative Extension Service have provided inspiration, valuable information, guidelines, and growing tips for home gardeners, enabling residents of our communities to reap the pleasures of personally growing and then witnessing the beauty of the flowers, trees, shrubs, lawns, or vegetable gardens they have planted;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature declares June 5 - 11, 1994, to

be Alaska Garden Week in order to recognize the importance of gardening to the state; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that through observance of Alaska Garden Week the Alaska State Legislature encourages all Alaskans to recognize the importance of gardening to our economy, enhancement of neighborhoods, and promotion of civic pride throughout the Great Land.
