AN ACT

Related to the authority of certain beverage dispensary licensees to stock alcoholic beverages in guest rooms and prohibiting certain room rentals for the purpose of providing alcoholic beverages to a person under 21 years of age.

1 Related to the authority of certain beverage dispensary licensees to stock alcoholic beverages
2 in guest rooms and prohibiting certain room rentals for the purpose of providing alcoholic
3 beverages to a person under 21 years of age.

5 * **Section 1.** FINDING AND PURPOSE. The legislature finds that international and
6 domestic travelers are accustomed to receiving hospitality services in their rooms for business
7 entertainment and personal enjoyment. The purpose of this Act is to enhance the
8 accommodations and services available to travelers visiting Alaska.

9 * **Sec. 2.** AS 04.11.090 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (g) A holder of a beverage dispensary license issued to a hotel, motel, resort,
11 or similar business that caters to the traveling public may stock alcoholic beverages
12 in guest rooms, for sale and consumption in the guest room only, if authorized by the
13 board. Alcoholic beverages stocked under this subsection shall be stocked by an
14 employee who is 21 years of age or older, may not be supplied or resupplied during
15 hours that the sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited as provided under

Chapter 3

1 AS 04.16.010(a) and (d), and shall be stored in a refrigerated unit using a key or
2 combination lock system within the guest room. A key lock system shall be designed
3 to prevent the removal of the key unless the refrigerated unit is locked. Except for the
4 licensee, or an agent or employee of the licensee, a key or combination enabling a
5 person to obtain alcoholic beverages stocked in a guest room may only be provided
6 to a guest who occupies the room and who is 21 years of age or older. The board
7 shall issue a permit to each licensee authorized to stock alcoholic beverages under this
8 subsection and may by regulation impose an administrative fee for the cost of issuing
9 the permit.

10 * Sec. 3. AS 04.16 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 04.16.055. ROOM RENTAL FOR PURPOSES OF CONSUMING
12 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. A person may not rent a room in a hotel, motel, resort,
13 or similar business for the purpose of providing alcoholic beverages to a person under
14 the age of 21 years.
