1 Establishing a House Special Committee on Military and Veterans' Affairs.

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:**

4 **WHEREAS** a large number of state residents currently serve in the military forces, work
5 for the military, or are veterans, and the military plays a vital role in the economy of the state; and

6 **WHEREAS** there is a need for a comprehensive review of issues involving military and
7 veterans' affairs;

8 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives that the House Special Committee
9 on Military and Veterans' Affairs is established to study issues, review laws, and propose
10 legislation relating to military and veterans' affairs; and be it

11 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the speaker of the House of Representatives shall
12 determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee, and shall appoint the
13 members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

14 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the House Special Committee on Military and Veterans'
15 Affairs may meet during and between sessions of the Nineteenth Alaska State Legislature and is
16 terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Twentieth Alaska State Legislature.
