12 * **Sec. 2.** AS 38.04.022(a) is amended to read:

13 (a) The revenue from the [SALE OF] state land disposal program shall be

1 deposited in the [A SPECIAL] state land disposal income fund [ACCOUNT] in the
2 state treasury. On June 30 of each fiscal year, the portion of that fund that
3 exceeds \$5,000,000 shall be deposited in the state general fund. The legislature may
4 appropriate money from the [SPECIAL] state land disposal income fund [ACCOUNT]
5 for expenditure by the Department of Natural Resources for necessary costs incurred
6 by the commissioner in the implementation of state land disposal programs authorized
7 under this title or for any other public purpose.

8 * **Sec. 3.** AS 38.05.082 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (f) The shore fisheries development lease program account is established in the
10 state treasury. The rents, fees, and other proceeds received by the department in
11 connection with the issuance of shore fisheries development leases under this section
12 shall be deposited into the account. The legislature may appropriate money deposited
13 into the account for the operation of the shore fisheries development lease program by
14 the department or for any other public purpose.

15 * **Sec. 4.** AS 38.05.110 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

16 (b) The timber receipts account is established in the state treasury. The
17 revenue from the sale of timber from state lands shall be deposited in the timber
18 receipts account. The legislature may appropriate money deposited into the timber
19 receipts account for implementation of the state timber disposal program by the
20 department or for any other public purpose.

21 * **Sec. 5.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2000.
