1 Relating to periods of probation for state employees; and providing for an effective date.

3 * **Section 1.** AS 39.25.150(7) is amended to read:

4 (7) a period of probation not to exceed one year before an appointment
5 to a position becomes permanent, **unless the period of probation is extended as set**
6 **out in a collective bargaining agreement under AS 23.40; however, [EXCEPT**
7 **THAT]** a permanent employee receiving a promotional appointment retains permanent
8 status in the service and job class from which appointed for the duration of the
9 probationary period and may be demoted to a former class without right of appeal,
10 notwithstanding AS 39.25.170, but, if the employee is dismissed from the service, the
11 appeal rights under AS 39.25.170 apply;

12 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
