

## CHAPTER 70.

## AN ACT

(H. B. 54)

To provide for the purchase of a law library for the use of the Attorney-General and other officials and to make an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Twenty-five Hundred (\$2,500.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the purchase of a law library and the necessary book cases, for the use of the Attorney-General, members of the Legislature and other Territorial Officials.

Appropriation for purchase of law library for Attorney General.

Section 2. That the law library and book cases of the late Hon. John G. Heid shall be purchased, and that the Governor of the Territory, the Attorney-General of the Territory and the District Judge of the First Judicial Division shall be and hereby are authorized to select and purchase such other books as are required to complete said set and such other books as are required; Provided that no purchases shall be made exceeding the amount herein appropriated. The Attorney-General shall have the care and custody of said Library. The Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska shall pay for the library and book cases purchased under the provisions of this act out of the funds hereby appropriated, upon vouchers signed by the parties from whom the same shall be purchased and approved by the Attorney-General.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
