SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 6

Be it resolved by the Senate of Alaska, the House Concurring, That no bill introduced after the forty-fifth day of this, the Third Session, shall receive consideration unless it would be considered an emergency act by three fourths of both houses.

Adopted by the Senate, Apr. 13, 1917.

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 7

To the President of the Duma,
Petrograd, Russia,

The Territorial Senate and House of Representatives, of the Territory of Alaska, in session assembled, extend the hand of greeting to our nearest Sister Republic, Russia.

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 8

Be it resolved by the Senate of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, the House of Representatives concurring, That Senator Heckman, the Senator from the 1st Division of Alaska be and is hereby permitted to introduce at this time a bill entitled: "An Act to authorize the Divisional Road Commission of each Road District in Alaska to expend monies appropriated for road purposes in aid of navigation, and declaring an emergency, and numbered Senate Bill No. 86.
