

school for not more than nine (9) school months in any one year. The amount so apportioned to each school district shall be paid to the treasurer of the district from the Territorial treasury upon the order and voucher of the Governor, as chairman of the Board of Education, as other territorial expenses are paid."

Section 2. That an emergency is hereby declared ^{Emergency.} to exist and this act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 61.

AN ACT

[S. B. 96]

For the relief of Laurence DeWitt.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of one hundred twenty-five (\$125.00) dollars is hereby appropriated out of the treasury of the Territory not otherwise appropriated, to be paid Laurence DeWitt of Mantasta, Alaska, as a refund to him for the payment through mistake of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars for an itinerant fur-buyer's license instead of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for a stationary fur-buyer's license, and the Treasurer of the Territory is authorized to pay such sum to the said Laurence DeWitt.
