## CHAPTER 120.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 103]

Making appropriations for the expenses of the Territory of Alaska for the last three quarters of the fiscal year 1929, beginning April 1st and ending December 31st, for the fiscal year ending December 31st, 1930, and for the quarter ending March 31st, 1931, except that the appropriation herein made for support of schools shall be used for expenses during the period from July 1st, 1929, to June 30th, 1931, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The following sums or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the expenses of the Territory for the last three quarters of the fiscal year 1929, beginning April 1st and ending December 31st, for the fiscal year ending December 31st, 1930, and for the quarter ending March 31st, 1931, except that the appropriation herein made for support of schools in cities and school districts shall be used for expenses during the period from July 1st, 1929, to June 30th, 1931.
