

CHAPTER 102.

AN ACT

[S. B. 105]

To repeal Chapter 38 of the Alaska Session Laws of 1917, being an Act to provide for direct election of National Committeemen and Delegates and Alternates to National Conventions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Repeal.

Section 1. That Chapter 38 of the Alaska Session Laws of 1917, be, and the said Chapter 38 is, hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 103.

AN ACT

[H. B. 92]

To appropriate funds for payment of deficiencies in the conduct of Territorial Offices and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Deficiency appropriations.

Section 1. The following sums or so much thereof as shall be required, are hereby appropriated out of any funds not otherwise appropriated from the Treasury of the Territory, for the following purposes:

- (1) To carry out the provisions of Chapter Thirty-One of the 1917 Session Laws of Alaska, as amended by Chapter Forty-One of the 1919 Session Laws of Alaska, relating to the rescue and relief of lost persons, the sum of\$963.14
- (2) To carry out the provisions of Chapter Seventy-Two of the Session Laws of 1929,

relating to the Territorial Boxing Commission, the sum of\$30.50.

These appropriations are supplementary to the appropriations heretofore made for the same purposes for the biennium which ended March 31st, 1933, and are made for the purposes of supplying deficiencies therein, and no claims shall be paid unless the same was properly authorized and incurred under the provisions of existing law, and is approved by the Governor.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist Emergency. and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 104.

AN ACT

[H. B. 53]

To appropriate funds for the payment of deficiency under Chapter 82, Session Laws 1929, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Eleven Hundred Thirty (\$1130.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the Treasury of the Territory for the purpose of paying, not to exceed One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars per year for the maintenance of each public library, incorporated, as provided in Chapter 82, Session Laws of 1929. Supplemental appropriation for Public Libraries.

This appropriation is supplementary to the appropriation heretofore made for that purpose for the biennium ended March 31, 1933.
