

resulting in the existing or threatened deprivation of a considerable number of families and individuals of the necessities of life, and making it imperative that work and relief be extended to the people, there is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00) dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction of rural schools in the Territory of Alaska.

Section 2. The Territorial Board of Education is hereby empowered to expend not to exceed the Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00) dollars so appropriated upon the erection and equipping of such rural schools in the Territory as in its judgment are necessary; to be paid out upon vouchers approved by the President of the Board of Education. Board of education to expend funds.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect upon its passage and approval. Emergency.

## CHAPTER 107.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 113]

To amend Section 499 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913, relative to the execution of conveyances of real property.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 499 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 499. A conveyance of lands, or of any estate or interest therein, may be made by deed, Conveyance of homestead, how made.

signed and sealed by the person from whom the estate or interest is intended to pass, being of lawful age, or by his lawful agent or attorney, and acknowledged or proved, and recorded as directed in this chapter, without any other act or ceremony whatever, Provided, however that in all deeds or conveyances of the family home or homestead made by a married man, or a married woman, the husband and wife shall join in such deeds or conveyances."

## CHAPTER 108.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 125]

To appropriate the sum of \$13,000.00 as a refund to public school teachers of Alaska and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Appropriation  
to provide re-  
fund of teach-  
er's pensions.

Section 1. The sum of Thirteen Thousand Dollars (\$13,000.00), or so much thereof as shall be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, to refund to public school teachers in the Territory of Alaska, or elsewhere, who have contributed to the Teachers Pension Fund of the public schools of Alaska under and pursuant to Chapter 83 of the 1919 Session Laws of Alaska, as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. TO WHOM AND HOW REFUND SHALL BE MADE: (1) Any public school teacher of or in the public schools of Alaska who shall have paid into the Treasury of Alaska the percentum of his or her wages as such public school teacher as required by Section 8, Chapter 83, Session Laws of Alaska for 1929, shall be
