

The aforesaid sum of money in this Section mentioned as herein set forth shall be expended under the direction of the Alaska Road Commission or such other agency as may be entrusted by the aforesaid Chief of Engineers to carry out the said suggested and recommended project.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist ^{Emergency.} and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 123.

AN ACT

[H. B. 94]

To appropriate the sum of \$12,547.00 to pay claims against the Territory of Alaska, for hospitalization, medical services, and for other purposes and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Twelve Thousand Five Hundred and Forty-seven Dollars (\$12,547.00) is hereby appropriated out of the monies in the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated to cover the following claims against the Territory of Alaska, as follows:

For hospital and indigent expenses.

To reimburse hospitals of the territory for the hospitalization of indigents during the biennium ending March 31, 1933 and not	

otherwise provided for, to be paid on vouchers approved by the Governor 6,000.00

Under this appropriation no allowance shall be made:

(a) For general hospitalization, including room, board, nursing and care, in excess of \$2.50 per day in the First and Third Divisions, nor in excess of \$3.00 per day in the Second and Fourth Divisions.

(b) For drugs and medicine, the reasonable cost.

(c) For the services of a physician not to exceed the rates prescribed by law.

All claims must be verified by one or more reputable persons and shall give the dates the services were rendered, the name, age, ailment, residence, and the known next of kin of the patient; and shall contain a statement that the patient, on account of some stated inability was financially unable to pay, and was and would continue to be unable to pay for such services, and that he has no relatives who should contribute to his care.

The Governor shall notify each hospital in the territory of the terms of this appropriation and on or after November 1st, 1933, shall pay all claims approved by him, or if they exceed this appropriation shall pay them pro rata.

CHAPTER 124.

AN ACT

[H. B. 18]

To provide for the construction of an airplane landing field at Cordova, Alaska; making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Road appropriation for landing field at Cordova, Alaska.

Section 1. The sum of Seventy-five Hundred Dollars (\$7500.00) is hereby appropriated out of the Third Division allotment of the Territorial road appropriation, for the construction of an airplane landing field adjacent to the town of Cordova, Alaska.

General Fund appropriation.

Section 2. The sum of Seventy-five Hundred Dollars (\$7500.00) is hereby appropriated out of monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, for the immediate construction of an airplane landing field adjacent to the town of Cordova, Alaska.

Territorial Highway Engineer to expend money.

Section 3. The several sums hereby appropriated shall be expended for the construction of the said field, under the direction of the Territorial Highway Engineer, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory upon warrants drawn on the Treasury specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn.

When appropriation available.

Section 4. The monies appropriated under the provisions of this Act shall not become available until
