CHAPTER 21.

AN ACT

[S. B. 27]

To amend Section 878 Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 94, Laws of 1931, by inserting an introductory paragraph.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 878 Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 94 Laws of 1931, be, and the same is, hereby amended by inserting an introductory paragraph to said section, to read as follows:

“Section 878. That the summons shall be served by delivering a copy thereof, together with a copy of the complaint prepared and certified by the plaintiff, his agent or attorney, or by the clerk of the court as follows:”
