CHAPTER 54.

AN ACT

[S. B. 78]

To repeal Section 15, Chapter 60 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1919, requiring Commissioners to transmit certain money to Territorial Treasury.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 15 of Chapter 60 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1919, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 55.

AN ACT

[S. B. 80]

To repeal Chapters 4 and 14 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1919.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Repeal.

Section 1. That Chapter 4 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1919, providing for the postponement of elections in municipalities where contagious disease is prevalent, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 2. That Chapter 14 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1919, fixing the qualifications of electors at

municipal elections, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 56.

To repeal Section 1, Chapter 56, Session Laws of Alaska, 1917 as amended by Section 1, Chapter 58, Session Laws of Alaska, 1923, providing for the issuance of marriage licenses by Notaries Public.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Chapter 56 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1917, as amended by Section 1 of Chapter 58 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1923, be, and the same is hereby repealed. ^{Repeal.}

CHAPTER 57.

AN ACT

[S. B. 64]
