

CHAPTER 77.

AN ACT

[H. B. 105]

To transfer to the General Fund of the Territory of Alaska, Twelve Thousand (\$12,000.00) Dollars, balance in fund, appropriated under and pursuant to Chapter 51, Session Laws, 1925, Chapter 32, Session Laws, 1929, and Chapter 98, Session Laws, 1929, being Acts providing for stocking public lands in the Territory of Alaska with certain game and fur bearing animals, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Twelve Thousand (\$12,000.00) Dollars, balance of appropriation for the purpose set forth in Chapter 51, Session Laws, 1925, and amendments thereto, is hereby transferred into the General Fund of the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 78.

AN ACT

[S. B. 6]

For relief of Rolland Osbourne of Matanuska, Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated from the moneys of the treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) to be paid to Rolland Osbourne of Matanuska, Alaska, for bounty on four (4) coyotes taken on date

of December 18, 1931, in the vicinity of Matanuska, Alaska.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist Emergency. and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval

CHAPTER 79.

AN ACT

[S. B. 43]

To appropriate Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for the use and aid of the Alaska Territorial Chamber of Commerce during the biennium commencing April 1, 1933; and authorizing the payment thereof by warrants drawn upon the Territorial Treasurer, and providing for the reporting by said Chamber of its activities and disbursements, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) is hereby appropriated out of monies in the Territorial Treasury for the use and aid of the Alaska Territorial Chamber of Commerce in conducting and maintaining its activities during the biennium commencing April 1, 1933; provided, however, that not more than 50% of said monies shall be expended for wages or salaries of officers or employees of said Chamber during said period. Appropriation for Territorial Chamber of Commerce.

Section 2. That before said Chamber of Commerce shall be paid any part of said money, reasonable proof shall be submitted on its behalf to the Governor of the Territory that Alaska local chambers of commerce, or similar civic organizations, whose combined local membership is not less than 500 dues paying members in such several local chambers, have joined or become Conditions for payment.
