

## CHAPTER 84.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 103]

To amend Section 1, Chapter 93, Session Laws of Alaska, 1931.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 1, of Chapter 93 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1931, be, and the same is, hereby amended by striking from line 2 thereof the following words "or shelter cabin".

## CHAPTER 85.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 108]

To create a commission to study the subject of Child Welfare and to recommend a program for care of children, making an appropriation, and repealing Chapter 69, Session Laws of Alaska, 1931.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The Governor shall appoint a commission of five (5) members whose duty it shall be to make a study of the administrative and other features of the Territorial Laws governing the subject of Child Welfare and other matters relating thereto, and to report its findings and recommendations to the next regular session of the Legislature.

Section 2. The commission shall have authority to employ the necessary clerical assistance and to incur the necessary contingent office expenses.
