

during the month covered by the voucher complied with the requirements of this Act and has furnished the service stated in said voucher.

**Appropriation.** Section 5. The sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to carry out the provisions of this Act.

**Repeal.** Section 6. Chapter 84 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1931, is hereby repealed.

**Emergency.** Section 7. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be effective from and after the date of its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 89.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 70]

To amend Section 26, of Chapter 65, Session Laws of Alaska of 1929; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 26, of Chapter 65, of the Session Laws of Alaska for 1929, be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

**Aid to mothers.  
when.**

“Section 26. Whenever it appears to the Governor, by clear and convincing evidence, that the mother of any child under sixteen (16) years of age (except native children who are eligible for provision by the Department of the Interior);

(1) Is a single woman or has a husband who is an inmate of a penal institution or is insane, or

who is physically or mentally so deficient as to be unable to support his family; and

(2) That she has no means wherewith to support such child except by her own labor; and

(3) That she is unable to properly support such child; and

(4) That she is a fit and proper person to have the care, control and custody of such child; and

(5) That she is, and has been for a period of One (1) year immediately preceding the filing of her petition for relief, a bona fide resident of the Territory of Alaska, the Governor shall have authority to award such mother a monthly allowance not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) where there is but one such dependent child. Where there is more than one such child he may allow a sum not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for the first child and the sum of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for each additional child.

The term "mother" within the meaning of this Section shall be deemed to include any female person standing in "loco parentis" to any such dependent child." Definition of "mother."

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect upon its passage and approval. Emergency.
