

CHAPTER 29.

AN ACT

[H. B. 37]

To provide for the rehabilitation and maintenance of the abandoned U. S. Signal Corps telegraph lines between Nulato and Unalakleet and between Rampart and Eureka and between Hot Springs and Nenana, and appropriating the money therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation for rehabilitating and maintaining abandoned U. S. Signal Corps Telegraph lines in certain localities.

Section 1. The sum of Twenty-five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of the monies in the Territorial treasury not otherwise appropriated to be expended during the biennium ending March 31, 1939 by the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the purpose of rehabilitating and maintaining the abandoned U. S. Signal Corps telegraph lines between Nulato and Unalakleet and between Rampart and Eureka and between Hot Springs and Nenana now being maintained for the use of the general public as telephone lines.

Payment to be made by treasurer—when and how.

Section 2. Payments under this Act shall be made by the Territorial treasurer upon properly prepared and certified vouchers that have been approved by the Highway Engineer.

Effective date.

Section 3. This Act shall become effective April 1, 1937.
