

CHAPTER 74.

AN ACT

[H. B. 78]

To amend Section 2168, Article IV, Chapter XLI, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to Workmen's Compensation Act.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 2168, Article IV, Chapter XLI, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows: Amended.

Section 2168. No compensation shall be paid hereunder for an injury which does not incapacitate the employee from earning full wages for a period of at least one day in addition to the day on which the injury occurred, but if incapacity extends beyond such period compensation shall commence on the second day after the injury. It shall be the duty of every person claiming compensation under the provisions of this Act for any injury sustained by him to make, or cause to be made, a report thereof to his employer immediately after sustaining the same, and no compensation shall be paid prior to the day on which such report is made. Compensation for injury under workmen's compensation act, when—report of injury required.
