

CHAPTER 9.

AN ACT

[S. B. 18]

To appropriate funds for harbor improvements at Petersburg, Alaska, in connection with dredging project of the United States, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
for Petersburg,
Alaska, Harbor
improvements.

Section 1. That the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated and made available and payable out of the road funds appropriated and allotted to the First Division of the Territory of Alaska for the biennium ending March 31, 1939; the same to be expended to reimburse the Town of Petersburg, Alaska, for harbor dredging project as recommended to the Secretary of War by the Chief of Engineers in report dated October 31, 1932, and transmitted to Congress by the Secretary of War December 5, 1932, and contained in Document No. 483, House of Representatives, 72nd Congress, Second Session.

How, when and
by whom paid.

Section 2. This appropriation shall be made immediately available, and the aforesaid sum shall be expended under the direction of the Territorial Highway Engineer, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory upon warrants drawn on the Treasury, specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn; and payments shall be made within the limits of the appropriation to the Town of Petersburg, Alaska, to reimburse it for all sums expended in dredging the port of Petersburg, to enable vessels to berth at the wharves, as set forth in Document No. 483 aforesaid. Payment shall be made upon vouchers submitted by the Common Council of the Town of Petersburg, Alaska, acting by and through its Mayor and Town Clerk.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, ^{Emergency.} and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 10.

AN ACT

[S. B. 15]

To authorize the Treasurer of Alaska to have tests made of weights and measures, and to make reports thereon.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The Treasurer of Alaska shall, from time to time or whenever called upon so to do, have tests made of weights and measures used in commercial institutions in the Territory of Alaska, and he shall make report to the Attorney General of Alaska, for prosecution under Section 4832, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, whenever the same is required thereunder. ^{Weights and Measures to be tested.}
