

## House Concurrent Resolutions

### HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1

WHEREAS, under the provisions of House Concurrent Resolution No. 3 of the Twelfth Session of the Legislature of Alaska, copies of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, which were used by the members of that session, were given to such members for their personal use at the end of the said session; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the members of the Thirteenth Session of the said Legislature, who were not members of the Twelfth Session to take the Compiled Laws used by them at the said Thirteenth Session with them at the close of the Extraordinary Session of the said Legislature:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that each such member, not heretofore furnished a volume of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be permitted to take the volume used by him during the present session with him at the close of the said Extraordinary Session.
