

CHAPTER 60.

AN ACT

[H. B. 122]

Making appropriations for the National Guard, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of \$56,860 or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is hereby appropriated for necessary expenses of the National Guard of Alaska for the biennium ending March 31, 1943, to be allocated as follows: \$5,000, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, for: Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 297th Infantry; for Medical Detachment, 297th Infantry, and for contingent office and travel expenses of the office of the Adjutant General of Alaska, at Juneau, and \$10,000 each to Companies A, B, C, D, and H, 297th Infantry, located at Juneau, Ketchikan, Fairbanks, Anchorage and Nome, respectively: Provided, however, that in the discretion of the Adjutant General for the Territory, an amount not exceeding ten per cent of the amount allotted to any unit specified may be reallocated to another, or other units as local conditions necessitate.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in effect immediately upon its approval.
