## CHAPTER 31

### AN ACT

[S. B. 40]

To repeal Sections 585, 586, 587 and 588 of Article III, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to Bounty on Eagles.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Sections 585, 586, 587 and 588 of Article III, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and they are hereby repealed.

## CHAPTER 32

### AN ACT

[S. B. 49]

To pay the sum of \$1,125.00 to the Seward General Hospital and the sum of \$269.00 to Dr. Ray G. Bannister of Seward for hospitalization and surgical services rendered Sigurd Wallsted, an indigent.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$1,125.00 to reimburse the Seward General Hospital for hospitalization furnished and the sum of \$269.00 to pay Dr. Ray G. Bannister of Seward for surgical services rendered to Sigurd Wallsted, an indigent.

## CHAPTER 33

### AN ACT

[S. S. B. 54]

To amend Section 653, Chapter V, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, defining the duties of the Attorney General.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 653 of Chapter V, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

It shall be the duty of the Attorney General to draft and prepare in proper form for introduction such bills, memorials or resolutions as may be requested by any member of the Legislature, the Governor, or any other Territorial official. He shall consult with members, officers and committees of the Legislature, when requested, upon pending bills or measures, and at the re-
