

## CHAPTER 45

## AN ACT

[S. H. B. 36]

Relating to domestic corporations and designation of agents to accept service of process, amending Section 1, Chapter 43, Session Laws of Alaska, 1941.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 1, Chapter 43, Session Laws of Alaska, 1941, be amended to read as follows:

“Section 1. That the provisions of Sections 942, 943 and 944, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as now or hereafter amended, shall be and are hereby extended to apply to every domestic business corporation, that is every corporation organized under the provisions of Chapter 8, Session Laws of Alaska, 1931, codified in Sections 901 to 936, inclusive, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, or any laws amendatory thereof.”

## CHAPTER 46

## AN ACT

[S. H. B. 31]

To compensate certain claimants for services rendered in taking care of dependent and destitute children, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the sum of \$631.25 is hereby appropriated out of the monies in the Treasury of the Territory

of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse Mrs. Mary Morrison for services rendered in taking care of dependent and destitute children, at the rate of \$25.00 per month, viz, Barbara Hildonen for the period, July 1, 1943, to and including July 14, 1944, and Lawrence Hildonen for the period, July 1, 1943, to July 22, 1944.

Section 2. That the sum of \$655.00 is hereby appropriated out of the monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, to compensate Miss Minnie Fields for services rendered in caring for dependent and destitute children, at the rate of \$25.00 per month, viz, Henry, Florence and Marlene Anderson for the months of March, April, May and June 1939; Terry and Dennis Gallagher for the months of September (1½) month, October, November, and December 1940; at the rate of \$30.00 per month, Knute and Philipe Felipe for the months of August, September and October, 1944.

Section 3. That the sum of \$75.00 is hereby appropriated out of the money in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, to compensate Miss Twila Porterfield for services rendered in caring for a dependent and destitute child at the rate of \$25.00 per month, viz, Mary Felipe for the months of August, September and October, 1944.

Section 4. Payments under this appropriation shall be made upon vouchers approved by the Director of the Alaska Department of Public Welfare.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
