

1940, as amended, to the Territory of Alaska and political subdivisions thereof, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Section 8 of the Selective Training Service Act of 1940, as amended, is hereby extended to the Territory of Alaska and its political subdivisions, it being the intent of this Act that all reemployment benefits granted by Section 8 of the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940 to any veteran who was in the employ of a private employer at the time of his induction into the armed forces of the United States shall, in the same manner and to the same extent, be granted to any veteran who was in the employ of the Territory of Alaska or any political subdivision thereof at the time of his induction into the armed forces of the United States.

Selective Service re-employment extended to Territorial employees.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 4

### AN ACT

[H. B. 20]

To amend Sec. 6 of Ch. 26, Session Laws of Alaska, 1945, pertaining to the Health Department, by adding a penalty clause, defining offenses and prescribing penalties.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Sec. 6 of Ch. 26, Session Laws of Alaska, 1945, is hereby amended to make the sub-title

thereof read as follows and by adding sub-section (c) thereto immediately after sub-section (b).

Section 6. Duties and Powers of the Board:  
Penalty Clause.

Penalty for violation of Health Dept. regulations.

(c) Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Act or any rule or regulation promulgated hereunder, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00, or imprisonment for not more than ONE year, and each day that such person continues any such violation shall be deemed a separate offense.

CHAPTER 5

AN ACT

[S. B. 22]

Establishing Department of Health Surplus Property Fund for purchase and resale of surplus medical supplies and equipment; making an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Purchase of surplus medical supplies.

Section 1. POLICY. It is the intention of the Legislature by this Act to make available to the use of the people of Alaska, at the authorized discount, a substantial amount of the medical equipment and supplies now or hereafter declared surplus property in Alaska by the armed forces of the United States.
