

1933, as amended, relative to the descent and distribution of real property.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That sub-section (1) of Section 4651, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Chapter 35, Session Laws of Alaska, 1946, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(1) If the intestate leave a widow or widower and issue, such widow or widower shall receive one-half of such real property, the remainder, or if the intestate leave no widow or widower, all of the real property left by the intestate, to be divided equally among his or her children and to the issue of any deceased child by right of representation, and if there be no child of the intestate living at the time of his or her death, such real property shall descend to his or her other lineal descendants, and if all such descendants are in the same degree of kindred to the intestate, they shall take such real property equally, otherwise they shall take according to the right of representation.

CHAPTER 13

AN ACT

[S. B. 24]

To amend Section 2 of Chapter 52, Session Laws of Alaska, 1943, relating to responsibilities of approving, certifying and disbursing officers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Chapter 52, Session Laws of Alaska, 1943, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The officer or employee approving or certifying a voucher shall (a) be held responsible for the existence and correctness of the facts recited in the certificate or otherwise stated on the voucher or its supporting papers and for the legality of the proposed payment under the appropriation or fund involved; (b) be required to give bond in the form and manner prescribed by Chapter 29, Session Laws of Alaska, 1943, to the Territory of Alaska, and approved by the Auditor of the Territory of Alaska, in such amount as may be determined by the head of the department, agency, or establishment concerned, pursuant to standards prescribed by the Board of Administration; the premium on such bond to be paid from funds made available for the administrative costs of such department, agency or establishment concerned; Provided, that officers already bonded under other provisions of law for the faithful performance of their duties shall not be required to give additional bond hereunder; and (c) be held accountable for and required to make good to the Territory of Alaska the amount of any illegal, improper, or incorrect payment resulting from any false, inaccurate, or misleading certificate made by him, as well as for any payment prohibited by law or which did not represent a legal obligation under the appropriation or fund involved.
