

## CHAPTER 14

## AN ACT

[H. B. 39]

To repeal Section 4828, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to fast driving over public bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 4828 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and it is hereby repealed.

## CHAPTER 15

## AN ACT

[H. B. 40]

To amend Section 4811, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, to make provision for the embezzlement as well as for the taking or stealing of property from another.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 4811, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be amended to read as follows: SECTION 4811. BUYING, RECEIVING OR CONCEALING STOLEN PROPERTY. Every person who buys, receives or conceals any money, goods, bank notes, or other thing which may be the subject of larceny and which has been

taken, embezzled or stolen from any other person, knowing the same to have been so taken, embezzled or stolen, shall be punished by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars and by imprisonment at hard labor not more than three years.

## CHAPTER 16

### AN ACT

[H. B. 52]

To establish the Alaska Pioneers' Memorial Fund, and authorize erection of a Pioneers' Memorial Statue on the grounds of the Pioneers' Home.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the Pioneers' Home Trust Fund, made up of money that has been contributed for the Pioneers and deposited in trust with the Territorial Treasury, for erecting a statue to the memory of the pioneers of Alaska, is hereby made available for the purpose for which it was intended, as follows:

Section 2. There is hereby established the Pioneers' Memorial Fund to be used as the repository for the money now in said Pioneers' Home Trust Fund. The Treasurer, as trustee of said fund, is hereby authorized and directed, upon consent of the trustees of the various Igloos of the Pioneers Lodge and others who may claim an interest in said money, to cover same into the Pioneers' Memorial Fund. Said Fund may also be used for deposit of other moneys that may be contributed for a Pioneers'
