

taken, embezzled or stolen from any other person, knowing the same to have been so taken, embezzled or stolen, shall be punished by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars and by imprisonment at hard labor not more than three years.

## CHAPTER 16

### AN ACT

[H. B. 52]

To establish the Alaska Pioneers' Memorial Fund, and authorize erection of a Pioneers' Memorial Statue on the grounds of the Pioneers' Home.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the Pioneers' Home Trust Fund, made up of money that has been contributed for the Pioneers and deposited in trust with the Territorial Treasury, for erecting a statue to the memory of the pioneers of Alaska, is hereby made available for the purpose for which it was intended, as follows:

Section 2. There is hereby established the Pioneers' Memorial Fund to be used as the repository for the money now in said Pioneers' Home Trust Fund. The Treasurer, as trustee of said fund, is hereby authorized and directed, upon consent of the trustees of the various Igloos of the Pioneers Lodge and others who may claim an interest in said money, to cover same into the Pioneers' Memorial Fund. Said Fund may also be used for deposit of other moneys that may be contributed for a Pioneers'

Memorial Statue, or contributed for other uses which will enhance the comfort or happiness of the Pioneers at the Home.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees of the Alaska Pioneers' Home is hereby authorized and directed to administer the Pioneers' Memorial Fund in the erection of a suitable statue depicting a gold-rush prospector and to designate a location on the grounds of the Pioneers' Home at Sitka for placement of such statue. Said Board of Trustees is also authorized to accept gifts toward securing enough money in said Fund to pay for such statue, provided, however, that after such amount is raised, the Board of Trustees may continue to accept gifts for deposit in said Fund for other proper uses as above mentioned, and to disburse same from time to time in conformity with the wishes of the donor or donors thereof.

## CHAPTER 17.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 51]

To repeal Section 3148, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, entitled "Auditor to prescribe and distribute forms".

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 3148, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is hereby repealed.
