

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Chapter 8, Session Laws of Alaska, 1943, is amended by adding the following at the end of the last paragraph thereof:

Provided, that such jurisdiction provision shall not be applicable in divorce or separate maintenance cases arising in the District Court, but in such cases the District Judge may, if he deems it best for the welfare of a child involved, order the child turned over to the custody of the Welfare Department. In such event the Welfare Department shall receive such support money as is ordered to be paid by the court and use same to carry out suitable arrangements for the child.

CHAPTER 22

AN ACT

[H. B. 70]

To appropriate the sum of \$1,361.15 for expenses of the Office of Attorney General for the biennium ending March 31, 1947; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,361.15, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the expenses of the office of the Attorney General for the biennium ending March 31, 1947. This

appropriation shall be in addition to moneys heretofore appropriated for said office for said biennium and shall be apportioned according to the following schedule:

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency clause.

CHAPTER 23

AN ACT

[H. B. 36]

To authorize the purchase of thirteen (13) new typewriters; two (2) new mimeograph machines; making an appropriation, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That a joint committee composed of the committee on printing in the House and the committee on printing in the Senate is hereby authorized to negotiate for the purchase or exchange of these machines for other machines suitable to do the work in the Legislature.
