

## CHAPTER 30

## AN ACT

[S. B. 2]

Providing for biennial Territorial audits; repealing Section 2708, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, Chapter 15, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, Chapter 44, Session Laws of Alaska, 1943, and Chapter 40, Session Laws of Alaska, 1945; and making an appropriation.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The Auditor of the Territory of Alaska shall audit or cause to be audited, at least once each biennium, the books, accounts and records of every department, officer, board, institution and individual engaged in handling funds of the Territory of Alaska, and shall submit a report of such audits to the Governor of Alaska, who shall submit the said report to the Territorial Legislature at its next regular session within ten days of the opening of the session. The period of such audits shall be on a calendar year basis. The Auditor shall also make such recommendations in the report to the Legislature as he shall deem necessary and proper.

Biennial audits.

Section 2. The Governor shall, each biennium, provide for an audit of the books, accounts and records of the Territorial Auditor, and the funds under his control, such audit to be made by an independent qualified accountant, or accountants.

Governor provides for audit of Auditor.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the monies of the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$20,000.00, or as much thereof as may be needed for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of this Act.

Appropriation.

Section 4. Section 2708, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, Chapter 15, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, Chapter 44, Session Laws of Alaska, 1943, and Chapter 40, Session Laws of Alaska, 1945, are hereby repealed.

## CHAPTER 31

### AN ACT

[S. B. 55]

To amend Section 971, as amended, and Sections 972 and 975, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to organizing of non-profit corporations; repealing Section 2 of Chapter 53, Session Laws of Alaska, 1943.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 971, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Chapter 87, Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, and Chapter 53, Session Laws of Alaska, 1943, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Sec. 971. Colleges, churches, libraries, social, etc., associations; articles of incorporation. Three or more adult persons, bona fide residents of the Territory, desirous of forming a corporation for a college, seminary, church, library, or any other benevolent, fraternal, social, religious, educational, charitable or scientific association, trades union or other labor organizations, commercial clubs or associations of business men, whose chief business shall be in the Territory, shall make and subscribe written articles of in-
