AN ACT

To amend Section 5405, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to suspended sentences.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 5405, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 5405. RIGHT TO SUSPEND SENTENCES IN CERTAIN CASES. Whenever any person shall be convicted of any crime except murder, burglary, arson, robbery or rape, the court may in its discretion, at the time of imposing the sentence upon such person, direct that such sentence, or any part thereof, be stayed and suspended until further ordered by such court, provided that, no suspension of sentence shall be revoked after the expiration of one year from the date of such sentence and no suspension of a sentence for imprisonment for more than one year shall be revoked after the expiration of the time for which the sentence was given, commencing with date of the judgment.
