

CHAPTER 36

AN ACT

[S. B. 56]

To repeal Section 528, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to Carrier Pigeons, as obsolete.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 528, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 37

AN ACT

[S. B. 72]

To amend Sections 2242 to 2245, inclusive, 2248, 2249, 2251, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to regulation of mining, and repealing Sections 2241, 2246 and 2252, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, and Sec. 5, Ch. 79, Session Laws of Alaska, 1935.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the words "Commissioner of Mines" are substituted for the words "Mine Inspector", "Inspector of Mines" or "Inspector" wherever appearing in Sections 2242 to 2246, inclusive, 2248 and 2249, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933.

Section 2. That the words "assigned to him by the Governor" appearing in lines four and five of Section 2242, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933", are hereby deleted; that the proviso contained in the last eight lines of said section is hereby deleted.

Section 3. That the last paragraph of Section 2248, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is hereby deleted.

Section 4. That Section 2249, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2249. ANNUAL REPORTS BY OPERATORS; CONTENTS. Each operator, at the beginning of the year, or as soon thereafter as practicable, shall register with the Commissioner of Mines at Juneau, Alaska, giving the name of the operator, the name of the manager, the name of the property and its location and the probable number of men to be employed during the coming season.

The Commissioner of Mines shall distribute blank forms requiring statistics of accidents, labor and production, and such other information as the Commissioner deems advisable, which shall be returned to and filed in the office of the Commissioner of Mines, to be made and used under the same conditions and restrictions as now required by the U. S. Geological Survey and the U. S. Bureau of Mines, by the person in charge of a mine or mine workings, on or before the 31st day of December of each year.

Section 5. That Section 2251, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2251. COMMISSIONER OF MINES TO COOPERATE WITH FEDERAL DEPART-

MENTS. It shall be the duty of the Commissioner of Mines of the Territory to cooperate with the heads of any of the executive departments of the United States in making investigations and in disseminating information with the view to stimulate mining, quarrying and metallurgical industries in the Territory, and to provide for the inspection of mines and the protection of the lives of miners.

Section 6. That Sections 2241, 2246 and 2252, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, and Section 5 of Chapter 79, Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 38

AN ACT

[H. B. 80]

To amend Section 3 of Chapter 4, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, to authorize transfer of management of the Seldovia Hospital from the Board of Directors of the Seldovia Public Utility District to the City Council of the incorporated city of Seldovia.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 4, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. That the management and control of the said hospital shall be in the hands of the City Council of the incorporated Town of Seldovia.
