

## CHAPTER 4

## AN ACT

[S. B. 8]

To appropriate for deficiencies in support of schools, for the school biennium ending June 30, 1947; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$214,784.88, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the support of schools within incorporated towns for the school biennium ending June 30, 1947.

Section 2. That there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$31,602.99, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the support of schools outside incorporated towns for the school biennium ending June 30, 1947.

Section 3. That there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$14,582.36, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the expenses of transportation of pupils authorized by Section 1289 (h), Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, for the school biennium ending June 30, 1947.

Section 4. That there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$21,129.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary for tuition to incorporated towns, as authorized by Section 1289 (i),

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency clause.

## CHAPTER 5

### AN ACT

[S. B. 15]

To amend Chapter 39, Session Laws of Alaska, 1946, relating to the levying of excise taxes on intoxicating liquor; and providing for an effective date.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 1 of Chapter 39, Session Laws of Alaska, 1946, which amends Section 2 of Chapter 58, Session Laws of Alaska, 1945, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Every brewer, distiller, bottler, jobber retailer, wholesaler or manufacturer, who sells intoxicating liquors in the Territory of Alaska or who consigns shipments of same into the Territory of Alaska, regardless of whether such liquors are brewed, distilled, bottled or manufactured within or without Alaska, shall pay on all malt beverages (alcoholic content of one per cent (1%) or more by volume), wines and hard or distilled liquors, the follow-
