

CHAPTER 42

AN ACT

[S. B. 73]

Pertaining to disposition of surplus Territorial property; amending Chapter 50, Section 1, Session Laws of Alaska, 1941, and repealing Section 3279, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Chapter 50, Section 1, Session Laws of Alaska, 1941, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That any obsolete or surplus property of the Territory for which there is no immediate or prospective use, excepting abandoned or obsolete school buildings and other school property, and any property remaining in the hands of or under the control of any commission or board created by the Territory after such commission or board for any cause ceases to function shall be taken possession of by the Board of Administration, who are hereby authorized to sell, lease, license or otherwise dispose of the same upon such terms as shall by them be deemed for the best interests of the Territory.

Surplus Territorial property.

Section 2. That Section 3279, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is hereby repealed.
