

CHAPTER 44

AN ACT

[S. B. 43]

Authorizing reimbursement to Lieut. Comdr. E. P. Chester Jr., U.S.C.G. Naval Aide to Governor of Alaska, of expense of Alaska relief mission in Seattle, Washington, and Portland, Oregon, during strike stoppage of shipping; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Reimbursement to Lieut. Comdr. E. P. Chester Jr., U.S.C.G. Naval Aide to Governor of Alaska of expense of his trip to Seattle, Washington, and Portland, Oregon, for the purpose of securing emergency shipping service to Alaska during the time of the recent shipping strike, covering the period from October 13 to December 19, 1946, in the amount of \$428.71 is hereby authorized to be paid out of the Governor's Emergency Fund.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
