

CHAPTER 70

AN ACT

[H. B. 42]

To forbid persons convicted of a felony from carrying concealed weapons and providing for penalties therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. No person who has been convicted of a felony involving assault, assault and battery, assault with a dangerous weapon, burglary, robbery and like crimes, under the laws of the United States, of the Territory of Alaska, or any State of the United States, or any other government or country shall own or have in his possession or under his custody or control any pistol, revolver or other firearm capable of being concealed upon the person.

Certain felon
may not carry
concealed guns.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions of Section 1 shall be punishable by imprisonment not exceeding five years or by a fine not exceeding \$500.00 or both.

Penalty.
