*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Reimbursement to the Tax Commissioner of expense of his recent trip to Puget Sound points for the purpose of auditing Territorial taxpayers' records and collecting Territorial taxes from companies doing business in Alaska, but maintaining headquarters in the Puget Sound area, is hereby authorized to be paid out of the applicable appropriation for the Department of Taxation, together with per diem covering such days as the Tax Commissioner was engaged in performance of duty for the Territory while on such travel status, in an amount not exceeding Four Hundred Forty Six Dollars and thirty one cents (\$446.31), notwithstanding the general travel restrictions contained in Chapter 26, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939.

## CHAPTER 72

### AN ACT

[S. B. 46]

To amend Section 2373, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to residence qualification of Electors.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 2373, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is amended to read as follows:

qualifications  
for incorporation  
of a city.

Sec. 2373. SUBMISSION TO VOTERS; QUALIFICATION OF ELECTORS; CONTENTS OF BALLOT. Every person who is of legal age and who is a citizen of the United States and who has resided continuously one year next preceding the election in the Territory of Alaska, and for thirty days next preceding the election in the precinct in which they vote, shall be qualified to vote at said or any subsequent municipal election. Said election shall be by printed or written ballot in the following form, to-wit:

“For Incorporation of the City of (name of proposed corporation)” or

“Against Incorporation of the City of (name of proposed corporation)”

## CHAPTER 73

### AN ACT

[S. B. 109]

To amend Section 1811, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, and to repeal Sections 1778, 1781, as amended, 1782 to 1786, inclusive, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to care of indigents.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Section 1811, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is hereby amended to read as follows:
