

CHAPTER 76

AN ACT

[S. B. 61]

Relating to Salaries of Territorial Employees; establishing a uniform salary schedule covering both elective and appointive Territorial officials; repealing acts or parts of acts in conflict herewith, and fixing an effective date.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. (a) The annual salaries of Territorial officials as hereinafter specified are hereby set and established as compensation in full for performance of the duties usually incident to their respective offices, and for all other Territorial duties assigned to them whether or not specifically mentioned:

- (10) Commissioner of Taxation,\$6,600.00
- (11) Director of Public Welfare,\$6,600.00
- (12) Director of Unemployment Compensation Commission,\$6,600.00

None of the above officials of the Territory shall be otherwise employed or receive from any other source, any other or additional compensation for their services. No outside employment.

(b) Any employee engaged as a full-time executive officer in charge of the program of any Board or Commission not hereinabove referred to shall, if authorized by his Board or Commission, receive an annual salary of not to exceed \$5,600.00.

(c) The annual salaries of chief deputies or chief assistants of the officials listed in sub-section (a) hereof are hereby set and established at \$5,500.00. Chief deputies.

(d) The annual salary of Territorial Assayers shall be \$5,500.00. Assayers.

(e) The annual salaries of all other Territorial employees not working for quasi-independent agencies administering lump sum appropriations, shall be fixed at a rate of 14% over their respective salaries in force on April 1, 1945. Employees salaries.

(f) The salaries of teachers and other employees paid from lump sum appropriations shall be in accordance with other provisions of law pertaining to them and in accordance with such employment contracts as they have or may have entered into with their respective agencies.

Section 2. All salaries above mentioned shall be paid in equal monthly installments upon vouchers drawn according to law.

Section 3. All provisions of previous laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed, and Chapter 44, Session Laws of Alaska, 1945, is specifically repealed.

Section 4. This Act shall become effective on and including April 1, 1947.

CHAPTER 77

AN ACT

[S. B. 116]

To appropriate supplemental funds for the Department of Public Welfare to be expended during the biennium ending March 31, 1947, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated,
