

(f) The salaries of teachers and other employees paid from lump sum appropriations shall be in accordance with other provisions of law pertaining to them and in accordance with such employment contracts as they have or may have entered into with their respective agencies.

Section 2. All salaries above mentioned shall be paid in equal monthly installments upon vouchers drawn according to law.

Section 3. All provisions of previous laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed, and Chapter 44, Session Laws of Alaska, 1945, is specifically repealed.

Section 4. This Act shall become effective on and including April 1, 1947.

CHAPTER 77

AN ACT

[S. B. 116]

To appropriate supplemental funds for the Department of Public Welfare to be expended during the biennium ending March 31, 1947, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated,

to be expended for purposes of relief of destitution by the Department of Public Welfare during the biennium ending March 31, 1947.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency clause.

CHAPTER 78

AN ACT

[C. S. S. B. 112]

To amend Section 2898, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to Escheats.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 2898, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is amended by changing the words "published for at least six consecutive weeks" to read "published once a week for at least six consecutive weeks" appearing in line 38 of said section. Publication notice.
